Charging and Remission Policy

- To levy any appropriate charges to parents in respect of all board and lodging requirements on residential visits, whether or not the residential visit is deemed to have taken place in School and College hours.
- To levy charges for activities held wholly or mainly outside School and College hours, where those activities would otherwise incur additional costs to the School and College.
It is the intention of the School and College to ensure as far as is reasonably possible, that no child should be disadvantaged solely by their parent's inability to pay.
- To request contributions on a voluntary basis for School and College activities in School and College time (eg. Educational visits), which can only run if sufficient funding is forthcoming, whilst making sure that no pupil is debarred from the activity (if it is financially viable) solely by the inability of the parents to pay.
- To leave to the Principal's discretion the proportion of the cost of an activity which, can be properly charged to the School and College budget, private funds or parents and in any event to ensure any charges made do not exceed the cost of providing the activity divided equally by the number of pupils participating.
- To require parents to pay for damage to School and College property for which children are responsible where reimbursement is appropriate.
- To request prior voluntary contributions towards the cost of materials/ingredients or technology. Where such charges are paid, the finished product becomes the property of the child/parents. Where charges are not paid, the finished article is the property of the School and College.
