One task to complete from a choice of two provided involving a given audience, form or purpose.</p> <p>Paper 2 – 1 hour 30 minutes</p> <p>Section A: Reading. 30 marks available One task on a poetry or prose text from Part 2 of the exam anthology.</p> <p>Section B: Imaginative Writing. 30 marks available One task to complete from a choice of three provided.</p>
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
