<p><b>English – Gateway</b> English Suite of Qualifications at Level 1, Level 2, Entry Levels 1, 2 and 3</p>	<p><b>Reading for purpose and meaning:</b> In this unit, learners will learn how to read short straightforward texts for purpose and meaning and use simple strategies to support understanding.</p> <p><b>Writing to communicate:</b> In this unit, learners will learn to write to communicate simple information.</p> <p><b>Listen and respond:</b> In this unit, learners will learn how to listen and respond in conversations and discussions.</p>	<p><b>Reading for information:</b> In this unit, learners will learn how to read straightforward written sources for information and to develop their understanding of spelling to decode words.</p> <p><b>Writing accurately:</b> In this unit, learners will learn to write legibly, using punctuation and spelling familiar words correctly.</p> <p><b>Speaking to communicate:</b> In this unit, learners will learn how to speak to communicate in different situations</p>	<p><b>Reading for purpose and meaning:</b> In this unit, learners will learn how to read short straightforward texts for purpose and meaning and use simple strategies to support understanding.</p> <p><b>Writing accurately:</b> In this unit, learners will learn to write legibly, using punctuation and spelling familiar words correctly.</p> <p><b>Engage in discussion:</b> In this unit, learners will learn how to engage in straightforward discussion in familiar contexts.</p>
<p><b>Delivery/ format of KS5 SLD English lessons</b></p>	<p>English lessons are structured and taught around Guided Reading and project-based learning. Learners are taught in small teaching groups of no more than 6 learners in a group.</p> <p>Projects will take the form of the following suggested topics:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Films</li> </ol> <p>Learners will produce a portfolio of evidence that will meet mandatory assessment criteria through the following units:</p>		

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Mandatory units:

- Reading – for purpose and meaning
- Reading – for information
- Writing – to communicate
- Writing – using basic punctuation and spelling
- Speaking, Listening and communication – Listen and respond
- Speaking, Listening and communication – Speak to communicate

Optional units: There are optional units to choose to complete the number of credits needed for the award (18 minimum)

For Reading, learners must complete two units totalling 6 credits

For Writing, learners must complete two units totalling 6 credits

For Speaking, Listening and communicating, learners must complete three units totalling 6 credits
