

Autumn Term 2 - York Class: Cooking

English

Focus: Recipes

Key learning skills: Pupils will develop their comprehension skills linked to recipes; identifying key information, answering questions and using what they know to fill in missing information. Pupils will also develop their understanding of key vocabulary; linking words to meanings and beginning to explain the vocabulary in simple terms.

Maths

Focus: Number and time

Key learning skills: Pupils will work on dividing amounts and solving number problems involving addition and subtraction. They will develop their understanding of time, using vocabulary linked to comparing and ordering times alongside using clocks to tell the time.

RHSE

Focus: Managing feelings and Keeping Safe

Key learning skills: Pupils will learn how to identify and express different feelings. They will participate in activities that involve sharing, taking turns and showing how they can make safe choices when working with others. Pupils will identify adults who can help them in social situations.

Food

Focus: Sweet mini pies/tarts

Key learning skills: Pupils will practise their rolling skills to make their pies and tarts and develop their weighing skills. They will think about the length of time taken to prepare ingredients and the sequence of the recipe. Pupils will also be learning how to safely use the oven to cook their pies and tarts.

Topics

Focus: Recipes and oven safety

Key learning skills: Pupils will further explore the recipes they will follow in their food lessons; identifying the ingredients and utensils/equipment and choosing the correct utensil needed to prepare the ingredients using the information they have been given. They will explore oven safety, including selecting appropriate equipment to place in an oven by thinking about the effect of heat on different materials.

Science

Focus: Animals including Humans - healthy eating

Key learning skills: Pupils will investigate the importance of nutrition, exercise and good hygiene. They will participate in activities that involve identifying different food groups and recognising how germs spread. Pupils will compare what animals and humans eat. They will plan a healthy meal that they will prepare and cook.

ICT

Focus: Using a keyboard to type

Key learning skills: Pupils will learn how to use a keyboard to type sentences. They will work on typing with both hands and learning how to type capital letters, numbers and full stops.

PE

Focus: Gymnastics

Key learning skills: Pupils will develop their skills when balancing, jumping, rolling and stretching through a variety of activities. There will be a mindfulness element to pupils' lessons where music will be incorporated to support them to challenge their thinking and learn new skills.

Music

Key learning skills: Pupils will continue using their speaking and singing voices through rhymes and songs, developing their sense of pulse and pitch. Pupils will learn about fast and slow tempo and loud and quiet sounds using their voices and instruments.

Art

Key learning skills: Pupils will study the flower paintings by Georgia O'Keeffe and create their own individual-inspired paintings. They will develop their skills in observational drawing, looking closely at the shape, form, colour and line of flowers. They will build on their knowledge, experimenting with oil pastel techniques such as sgraffito and practise blending colours together. They will experiment with ways of making parts of their painting three-dimensional.

Outdoor Learning: Pupils will visit Wat Tyler for their forest school sessions. They will develop their speaking and listening skills and social skills in a different context. Pupils will explore the outdoors and experience the benefits of the natural world around us, learning about how to keep safe.

Community: Pupils will visit the supermarket on alternate weeks to buy the ingredients required for their weekly food lesson; developing their road safety skills, navigating the aisles to find products, asking for help and using the tills. When remaining onsite, pupils will use a recipe to write a shopping list, search for the ingredients online and practise using money within a role play shop.
