Nature of support - funding used to support all eligible pupils by:

- Learning to learn approaches - Small group interventions in literacy, math's and PSD, with relevant training and resources. As well as training to help pupils to set goals and staff to effectively monitor and evaluate pupil's development with support from S&L, OT and our school F.I.T team.
- Social/emotional support – supporting the development of our Lifeskills and alternative provision curriculum to ensure that learning is practical/ real life and equips our pupils for the next stage in their learning.
- Extension of out of school activities to support with social, emotional development of pupils.
- Tuition or small group support for most able pupils to achieve qualifications at a higher level or not offered on Castledon's site.
- Behaviour interventions/ support – resources and training to develop our therapeutic approach and use of Essex Steps.
- Digital technology – technology purchased for problem solving, more open-ended learning and to support with individualised learning
- Outdoor learning experiences – supporting a curriculum that encourages a love of the outdoors both within the curriculum and with after school provisions as well as supporting with community experiences.
- Parental involvement - Home/school support work with strategies and resources particularly to support with SEMH/ ASD needs, as well as facilitating parental coffee mornings inc. training and support with accessing other services.
- Reading support – to continue to develop our use of fresh start and RWI as well as encourage a love of reading through up to date resources and staff development.
